I. Program inventory

This RME is to rename the College of Applied Sciences and Arts (CASA) to the College of Health Services and Human Science. This RME will also administratively transfer academic units that are not affiliated with health services and human science to other colleges. Specifically, the School of Architecture will be administratively transferred to the College of Mass Communications and Media Arts. The Departments of Aviation Management and Flight, Aviation Technologies and Automotive Technology will be administratively transferred to the College of Engineering. The School of Information Systems and Applied Technology will be administratively transferred to the College of Business.

II. Reason for proposed action

This action is in part a response to the Financial Sustainability Plan approved by the SIU Board of Trustees in July 2017. In this plan, the campus reported efforts to reorganize some units in the colleges of Mass Communications and Media Arts, Liberal Arts, and Applied Sciences and Arts into a College of Media, Design, and Fine and Performing Arts (name to be determined) in order to allow for strategic curricular changes and efficiencies as well as to attract students. This RME includes the administrative transfer of the School of Architecture to the College of Mass Communications and Media Arts.

Renaming the College of Applied Arts and Sciences to the College of Health Services and Human Science strategically repositions the College and provides an opportunity to highlight programs in health and human science related fields. This will attract students and faculty to work in an environment that promotes collaboration in curriculum, outreach and research.

Because of this shift in focus and the proposed College name change, the Departments of Aviation Management and Flight, Aviation Technology and Automotive Technology are not well-aligned with the renamed College of Health Services and Human Sciences and will be administratively transferred to the College of Engineering. Aligning these programs with the College of Engineering promotes strategic curricular changes and efficiencies as well as an opportunity to strategically present and market our programs to attract students. There is a separate RME to rename the

College of Engineering.

In addition, the School of Information Systems and Applied Technology will be administratively transferred to the College of Business. Aligning these programs with the College of Business promotes strategic curricular changes and efficiencies as well as an opportunity to strategically present and market our programs to attract students. There is a separate RME to rename the College of Business.

III. Program delivery mode

Same as current delivery mode.

IV. Anticipated budgetary effects

There will be costs associated with the marketing of the renamed colleges (although it should be noted that marketing costs for the existing colleges would already be budgeted, so we anticipate these costs will be minimal) as well as managing the increased size of the receiving colleges. This will be partially off-set by the potential to attract and retain students, and by reductions in complexity in the current College of Applied Sciences and Arts. Opportunities for future strategic curricular changes and efficiencies are also possible. Budget lines, state and local accounts, and foundation accounts will move with the transferred academic units.

V. Arrangements to be made for (a) affected faculty, staff and students; and (b) affected equipment and physical facilities

There will be no reduction in faculty resulting from this RME. There is no impact on Faculty tenure or tenure-track status. Continuing NTT faculty will retain their continuing status. For term NTT faculty there will be no loss of progress (i.e., years of service) toward continuing conversion. There are no changes in curricula, so there is no effect on current students. All faculty and staff currently assigned to an academic unit that is moving administratively to another college will be transferred administratively with the existing academic unit. For continuing A/P staff members, there will be no loss of continuing status. For civil service staff members there will be no loss of seniority / service credit. In the future, staff members may be re-assigned or added depending on the needs determined by the two colleges. All inventory will be assigned to the receiving College. The physical facilities will remain the same in the short term. A campus wide space plan is being developed that will address future space planning.

VI. Will other educational units, curricula, or degrees be affected by this action?

The plan has no direct effect on other educational units, or on the existing curriculum and degree programs. In general, the renaming and administrative transfer of units should build on the existing collaboration between the units, and position the colleges for future innovation in curriculum and research. Academic deans are expected to present this RME to their College, and to solicit and report faculty input.
